For the second consecutive week Bromley picked up maximum points after coming from behind and missing a host of chances.

The visitors had most of the possession in the first 15 minutes but were stunned two minutes later when from a corner Jay Champion headed past keeper Tim Jackson to put the home side in front.

Bromley continued to attack with a good supply of crosses from wingers Clay and Ferneyhough being wasted and only had themselves to blame going in the break 1-0 down.

After the restart they fell further behind when in the 51st minute Legionnaires capitalised on some sloppy defending and Steve Thacker was on hand to stroke the ball home.

With Bromley looking at a mountain to climb they finally responded two minutes later when a kick by keeper Jackson found Crooks who in turn laid it into the path of striker Neves who fired the ball into the net for his third goal of the season.

They didn't have to wait long to draw level when only a minute later man of the match James Stevenson laid the ball into the path of Ashley Clay who found the corner of the net.

The visitors were beginning to make their chances count and in the 61st minute the comeback was complete after a cleverly worked corner found Will Ferneyhough unmarked in the penalty area to head home his first goal for the club in his first full start.

The home side went in search of an equaliser but couldn't find a way through so Bromley held on to take the honours doing it the hard way not for the first time this season.
